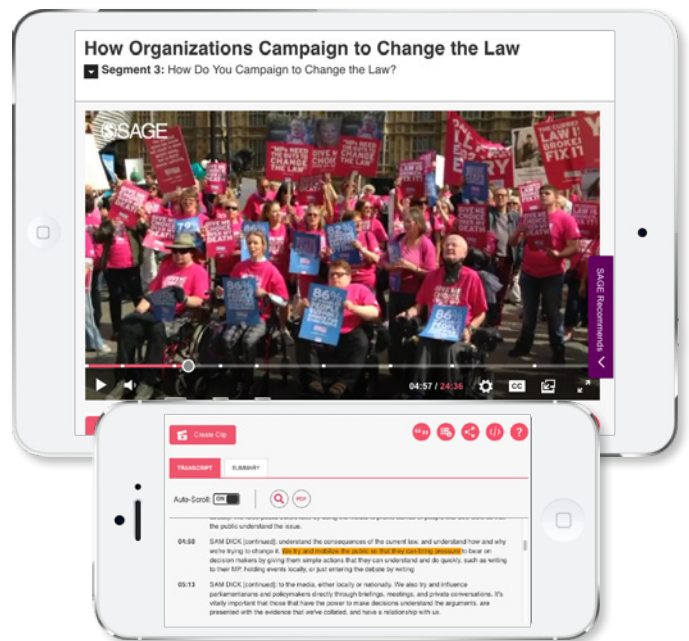
The **SAGE Video Politics & International Relations Collection** supports students and researchers at all levels. With 73% of the content exclusive to SAGE, this collection includes the following:
