Callouts for the video player interface:

- Move to a different segment of the video
- HTML5 player
- Create a clip with a unique URL
- Speed up or slow down play, use closed-captioning, change video size
- Auto-scroll; searchable, downloadable transcript
- Shortcut keys
- Embed your clips in your course management system
- Cite, share via email or social media, save to a playlist, or embed HTML code in a web page
