-  **Develop a lesson plan**
 - Connect to research question/use case
 - Align with learning outcomes
-  **Design training activity**
-  **Curate content** related to an activity, example research question, or course via a reading list

DELIVER



-  **Illustrate access to resource through library website**
-  **Log in to personal profile and highlight benefits**
 - Save searches
 - Build and share reading lists
 - Create and store custom video clips
-  **Demonstrate search options**
 - Quick and advanced search
 - Browse by discipline or content type
 - Research tools (Methods Map, Project Planner, Which Stats Test)
 - Public reading lists
-  **Review results page options and features**
 - Filter options (discipline, date range, etc.)
 - Save search (must be logged into personal profile)
 - Add to list (must be logged into personal profile)
-  **Reference platform tools**
 - Download, Cite, Share, Embed, and Get Link options
 - Save to reading list (must be logged into personal profile)
 - Video player functionality (Closed Captions, playback speed adjustment, video quick keys, etc.)
-  **Tie together via training activity**
 - For patrons, researchers, and students**
 - Incorporate hands-on activity
 - Encourage 1 or 2 learners to share results
 - Wrap up with facilitated Q&A
 - For faculty, practitioners, and instructors**
 - Discuss teaching applications of Cases and Datasets
 - Demonstrate embed options for Video, Datasets, and Reading Lists
 - Navigate to Faculty Resources and sample assignments
 - Incorporate hands-on activity
 - Encourage 1 or 2 learners to share results
 - Wrap up with facilitated Q&A
-  **Follow up**
 - Share links to example reading lists and support resources (e.g. FAQs, user guides, LibGuides, etc.)
 - Provide link to session recording if presented virtually
